Who can participate? The Award is directed towards students, designers, engineers, scientists, makers, creators, inventors, artists, journalists and teachers but everyone who has an idea, concept, project, initiative, prototype or even a solution already in market which supports less plastic packages is welcome to take part. Also it can be a campaign, educational or journalistic project related to the topic.

The entries will be judged in September will be announced and celebrated in the fall 2021.

Last year, the BEYONDPLASTIC AWARD received over 100 entries from across the world. The winners included Paula Nerlich's "Aqua Faba Foam", a biomaterial made from the byproduct of chickpeas, Rania Elkalla's "Shell Homage" material made from waste egg and nut shells, and Allan Gomes' "Coolpaste" sustainable toothpaste packaging.
